Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

For the same set of allegations, Respondent No.2 has instituted a case in S.T.C.No.44 of 2024 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Pakala, for the alleged offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881' and has also filed the instant complaint, which was registered as Crime No.41 of 2026 at Pakala Urban Police Station, Tirupati District.

In view of the above, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in FIR No.41 of 2026 on the file of Pakala Urban Police Station, Tirupati District, until further orders.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr.VenkataRaoChalamalasetty, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

The fee for the mediator will be fixed at a later point of time.

Petitioner and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 05.05.2026 or any other convenient date for both the parties and the mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.
