WHEREAS the Petitioner/Accused above named through their Advocate Sri. THOTA ASHOK KUMAR presented this Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C/ under Section 528 of BNSS , praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to i) Quash FIR No. 348/2025 dated 06.12.2025, registered at Satyanarayanapuram Police Station, NTR District, for alleged offences under Section 126(2), 115(2) read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Sanhita, 2023, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom against the Petitioners/AccusedNos. 1 to 6 and

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit/memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri THOTA ASHOK KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRLP should not be admitted on or before Summer Vacation, 2026 for which date the case stands posted for hearing;

**IA NO: 2 OF 2026**

Petition under Section 482 of CrPC/under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings, including investigation, in FIR No. 348 of 2025 dated 06.12.2025, registered on the file of Satyanarayanapuram Police Station, NTR District, for the alleged offences under Sections 126(2), 115(2) read with 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, pending disposal of the above Criminal Petition,.

**The Court made the following: ORDER**

**Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.**

**Issue notice to respondent No.2.**

**The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.**

**It is submitted by the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor that some of the petitioners have not cooperated with the Investigating Officer in getting served with a notice contemplated under Section 35(3) of 'the BNSS'.**

**The alleged offences levelled against the Petitioners/Accused are punishable with imprisonment for less than seven (07) years.**



In the meanwhile, the Investigating Officer is directed to comply with the guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court in *Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar*<sup>1</sup>, and also with the provisions of Section 35(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for brevity, 'the BNSS'). However, the petitioners are directed to cooperate with the Investigating Officer, and the Investigating Officer may proceed with the further investigation. In the course of investigation, if it is noticed that the petitioners have committed any offence punishable with imprisonment beyond seven years, the Investigating Officer is at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.

The matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. Jala Sanjaya Virgil, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 05.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.348 of 2025 on the file of Satyanarayanapuram Police Station, NTR District.
