ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Petitioner No.1/Accused No.1 is the husband of the daughter of Respondent No.2. The petitioners/Accused Nos.2 to 4 are the in-laws of the daughter of Respondent No.2.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Sri P.Mohan Rao, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 05.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator. The parties shall appear before the mediator either through physically or virtual mode depending on their convenience.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.5805 of 2025 on the file of the learned IV Additional Junior Civil Judge, Guntur.
