**IA NO: 1 OF 2026**

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the Petitioner in C.C. No. 200 of 2023 on the file of the court of Learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Udayagiri, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3200 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

**The Court made the following: ORDER**

**Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.**

**Issue notice to respondent No.2.**

**The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.**

**Since the alleged offences are compoundable in nature and in view of the fact that the Petitioner/Accused has returned some of the deceived money to Respondent No. 2.**

**Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, and the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioner, the matter is referred to mediation.**

**Sri.P.Mohan Rao, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.**

**The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.**

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 05.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.200 of 2023 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Udayagiri.
