SRINIVASA RAO NARRA presented this Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C/ under Section 528 of BNSS , praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to Quash the proceedings in Crime No.27/2026 against the Petitioners/Accused No.1 to 3 for the offence punishable U/s.79, 351(2) r/w 3(5) B.N.S. on the file of Udayagiri Police Station, SPS Nellore District

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit/memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri SRINIVASA RAO NARRA Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C/ Under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to Stay of all further proceedings including arrest of the Petitioners/Accused No.1 to 3 in Crime No.27/2026 for the offence punishable U/s.79, 351(2) r/w 3(5) B.N.S. on the file of Udayagiri Police Station, SPS Nellore District, until disposal of the quash petition

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Since all the alleged offences are punishable with imprisonment of less than seven years, the Investigating Officer is directed to adhere to the procedure contemplated under Section 35(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023¹. In the course of investigation, if it is revealed that the Petitioner has also committed any offences punishable with imprisonment of more than seven years, the Investigating Officer may proceed in accordance with law.

The alleged offences are compoundable in nature, the matter is referred to mediation.

Learned Principal Sessions Judge, Nellore is directed to appoint mediator in this matter to mediate the case.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 05.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation proceedings for amicable settlement of the dispute.

The Station House Officer concerned and learned Trial Court is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

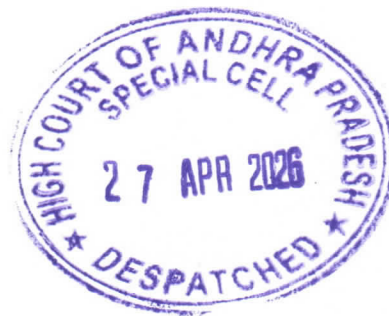
