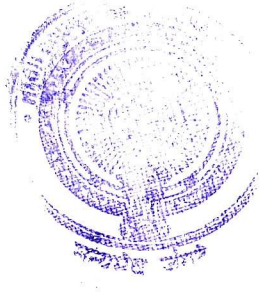

WHEREAS the Petitioners/Accused above named through their Advocate Sri K Naga Phanindra, presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for the records in CC. NO. 4133/2025 on the file of the Hon'ble Judicial First Class

Magistrate Special Mobile Court, Kurnool, Kurnool District and quash the same

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri K Naga Phanindra Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause on or before 15.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings including appearance of petitioners in CC.No.4133/2025 on the file of the Hon'ble Judicial First Class Magistrate Special Mobile Court, Kurnool, Kurnool District, Pending disposal of CRLP No. 3212 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

There was a civil suit in O.S.No.489 of 2016 on the file of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kurnool filed by the associate of the respondent No.2. The said suit was dismissed on 30.12.2024. An appeal was filed before the learned District Judge, Kurnool in A.S.No. 13 of 2025 and the same is pending for consideration. When the said dispute is pending, the respondent No.2 has lodged a complaint against the petitioners, which was registered as a case in Cr.No.170 of 2025 for the alleged offences punishable under sections 329(3), 324(4), 351(2) read with 3(5) of the Bharathiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023' (For brevity 'the BNS') of Kurnool Taluk Police Station. After completion of investigation, police have filed charge sheet.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, in view of the alleged offences are compoundable in nature, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. Ch.V.V.Satyanarayana, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 05.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation proceedings for amicable settlement of the dispute.

The Station House Officer concerned and learned Trial Court is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.4133 of 2025 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Special Mobile Court, Kurnool.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.
