The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

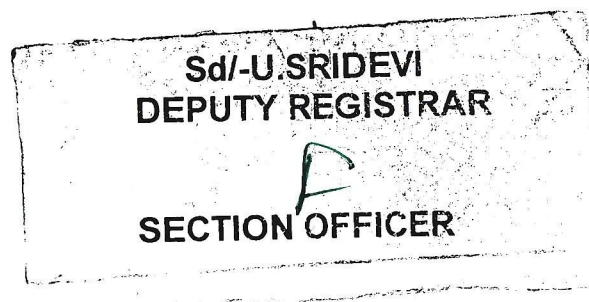
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Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the police have not yet filed charge sheet.

Since all the alleged offences are punishable with imprisonment for less than seven years, the Investigating Officer is directed to adhere to the procedure contemplated under Section 35(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023¹. In the course of investigation, if it is revealed that the Petitioner has also committed any offences punishable with imprisonment of more than seven years, the Investigating Officer may proceed in accordance with law
