The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent Nos.3 and 4 and file proof to that effect. The de-facto complainant originally filed a complaint before the police, which was registered as a case in Crime No.97 of 2006 on the file of Parchur Police Station. After thorough investigation, the police filed a charge sheet referring the case as false. Challenging the same, the de-facto complainant filed a protest petition, which was also dismissed. Thereafter, the de facto complainant filed a private complaint before the learned Jurisdictional Magistrate, which was taken on file and PRC proceedings were issued. It is pertinent to mention that a learned Single Judge of this Court, in respect of Accused Nos.6, 9 to 11, 15 to 22, 24 to 27, and 29 to 32, quashed the proceedings pending against them in CrI.P.No.3945	Contd...

of 2012, *vide* order dated 28.02.2015.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in S.C.SPL.No.91 of 2023 on the file of the learned VII Additional District and Sessions Judge, Ongole, until further orders.
