AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri A RAJENDRA BABU Advocate for the Petitioner, Public Prosecutor for R1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.3 and 4 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Sections 482 of Cr.P.C/528 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including the appearance of the petitioners/Accused No.2, 3, 12 and 28 in SC.SPL.No.91/2023 on the file of VII Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Ongole, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3199 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent Nos.3 and 4.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent Nos.3 and 4 and file proof to that effect.

The de-facto complainant originally filed a complaint before the police, which was registered as a case in Crime No.97 of 2006 on the file of Parchur Police Station. After thorough investigation, the police filed a charge sheet referring the case as false.

Challenging the same, the de-facto complainant filed a protest petition, which was also dismissed. Thereafter, the de facto complainant filed a private complaint before the learned Jurisdictional Magistrate, which was taken on file and PRC proceedings were issued.

It is pertinent to mention that a learned Single Judge of this Court, in respect of Accused Nos.6, 9 to 11, 15 to 22, 24 to 27, and 29 to 32, quashed the proceedings pending against them in CrI.P.No.3945 of 2012, vide order dated 28.02.2015.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in S.C.SPL.No.91 of 2023 on the file of the learned VII Additional District and Sessions Judge, Ongole, until further orders.
