ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The respondent No.2 has lodged a complaint against the petitioners with a considerable delay, and the said delay has not been explained in the threepage typed copy of the complaint.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, and the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioners, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms.Hemalatha Minchala, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

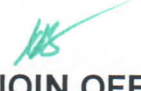
The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 05.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement. Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.51 of 2025 on the file of Palasamudram Police Station, Chittoor District.
