The averments in the affidavit filed by the petitioner <i>prima facie</i> shows that the petitioner is none other than the wife of the respondent/husband, due to the matrimonial disputes between both the parties, the petitioner/wife is residing separately at Guntur along with her minor daughter, aged about six (06) years. The averments in the affidavit filed by the petitioner <i>prima facie</i> further show that the petitioner filed a Maintenance Case <i>vide</i> F.C.O.P.No.791 of 2025 under Section 144 (1) (a) (b) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, on the file of the Family Court-cum-Additional District & Sessions Court, Guntur, and the same is pending adjudication. Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that the respondent/husband filed H.M.O.P.No.264 of 2024, on the file of the learned Principal Senior Civil Judge, Machilipatnam, seeking restitution of conjugal rights under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, and the same is pending adjudication. Learned counsel for the petitioner would further contend that the petitioner/wife has been residing separately at Guntur house along with her minor daughter aged about 6 years and	

	the distance between the Guntur and Machilipatnam is more than 100 kms and it is very difficult for the petitioner/wife to attend the case proceedings in H.M.O.P.No.264 of 2024, on the file of the learned Principal Senior Civil Judge, Machilipatnam, on each and every adjournment without any male assistance and that she is constrained to file the present transfer petition. Perused the record. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and for the reasons mentioned in the accompanying affidavit, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings including the appearance of the petitioner, i.e., the respondent in H.M.O.P.No.264 of 2024, on the file of the learned Principal Senior Civil Judge, Machilipatnam, till 15.06.2026. Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to takeout personal notice to the respondent through Registered Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service before the Registry. <u>Tr.C.M.P.No.125 of 2026</u> ADMIT.
