Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of

Writ of Mandamus declaring the Impugned orders vide Rc.No.DSH-18/47/2023-VIG-APVVP, dated 30.03.2026 of the 2nd respondent termination of the services and ordering recovery of the amounts from the petitioner are as illegal, arbitrary, contrary to law, violation of principles of natural justice and violation of provisions of Article 14,16 and 21 of constitution of India and law laid down by the Honble Supreme Court of India in State of Punjab and others Vs Rafaiq Masih (white washer) and others (2015 (4) see 334) and set aside the above impugned Proceedings and consequently direct the respondents to continue the petitioner as Staff Nurse (contract Basis) in the O/o Mother child Hospital (MSH), Adoni, Kurnool District and not to recover any amount from the Petitioner.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to Suspend the Impugned proceedings vide Rc.No.DSH-18/47/2023-VIG-APVVP dated 30.03.2026 of the 2nd respondent and direct the respondents to continue the petitioner as Staff Nurse (Contract Basis) in the O/o Mother Child Hospital (MCH), Adoni, Kurnool District, Pending disposal of WP No.10582 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to recover any amount from the petitioner and not to initiate any criminal proceedings against the Petitioner in pursuant to the orders vide Rc.No.DSH-18/47/2023-VIG-APVVP dated 30.03.2026 of the 2nd respondent, Pending disposal of WP No.10582 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Bala Ramesh Yalavarthi, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of GP for Services I for the Respondents, the Court made the following.

ORDER

The writ petition is filed aggrieved by the impugned order dated 30.03.2026, wherein the services of the petitioner was terminated on the ground of petitioner obtaining the employment by morphing the marks and made lamination in colour Xerox.

2. The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the termination of the petitioner was made without giving any notice or without giving any opportunity of hearing to the petitioner the termination orders were passed.

3. He further submits that the respondents have also issued the proceedings ordering to recover the entire salary paid to the petitioner during her service and hence he prays to stay the impugned proceedings.

4. Considering the said submissions and on perusal of the material on record, there shall be stay of the impugned proceedings dated 30.03.2026 of the 2nd respondent for a period of eight weeks.

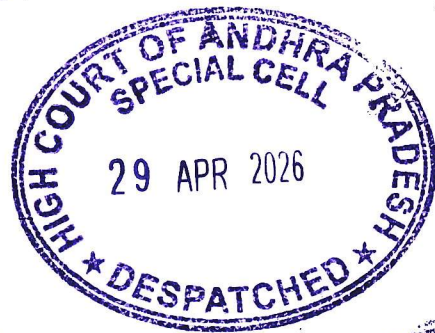
