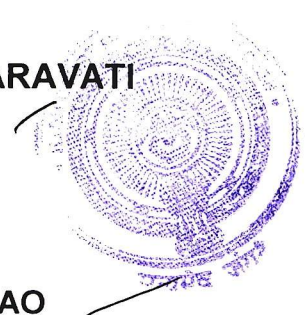

"Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. ✓

The petitioner/Accused No.1 and respondent No. 2 have been in a consensual relationship since 2017. ✓

Considering the entire allegations leveled against the petitioner and the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation. ✓

Mr. K.Muni Reddy Bala Prasad, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case. ✓

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard. ✓

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time. ✓

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 05.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation proceedings for amicable settlement of the dispute.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator. ✓

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in P.R.C.No.46 of 2025 on the file of the learned Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Vijayawada. ✓

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report."
