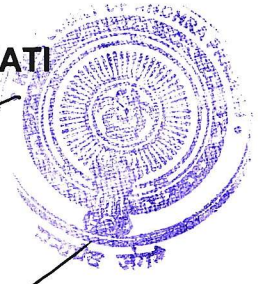

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri HANUMANTHA RAO BACHINA presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 (482 of Cr.P.C) is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds of criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to Call for the records pertaining to FIR No.210/2025 dated 28.11.2025 on the file of Dargamitta Urban Police Station, Nellore and quash the same in the interests of justice, further Direct the de-facto

complainant to participate in arbitration proceedings as provided under Clause 2 of the Master Franchisee Agreement dated 22.05.2025;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Hanumantha Rao Bachina, Advocate for the Petitioner and Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRLP should not be admitted on or before 15.06.2026 for which date the case stands posted for hearing;

IA NO: 2 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds of criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings including the arrest of the Petitioner in FIR No.210/2025 dated 28.11.2025 on the file of Dargamitta Urban Police Station, Nellore, pending disposal of CRLP No.3221 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioner and respondent No.2 entered into a Franchise Agreement for the supply, transportation, and sale of Veehan Foods & Beverages, pursuant to which services were rendered by respondent No.2. The petitioner paid an amount of Rs.6,00,000/- but has not paid the remaining Rs.5,80,000/-, which, as alleged by respondent No.2, includes additional benefits.

The entire nature of the transaction between the petitioner and respondent No.2, as ensured, appears to be civil in nature.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr.A.Sai Naveen, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 05.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation proceedings for amicable settlement of the dispute.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.210 of 2025 on the file of the Dargamitta Urban Police Station.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.
