Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to Stay all further Proceedings in CC No.274 of 2025 against the Petitioner/Accused No. 1 pending on the file of the Learned Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class cum Additional Junior Civil Judge at Mangalagiri under Section 85, R/w 3[5] of BNS, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3227 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioners/Accused No.1 is the husband of the respondent No.2.

Their Marriage was performed on 04.02.2024. Respondent No.2 filed a complaint not only against the petitioner but also against his parents and relatives.

Considering the entire allegations leveled against the petitioner and the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr.Habeeb Sheikh, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the Mediator on 05.05.2026, or on any other convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation proceedings for amicable settlement of the dispute.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.274 of 2025 on the file of the learned II Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Mangalagiri.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.
