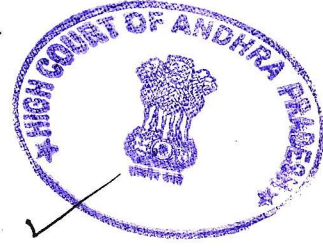

Section 6-A proceedings are pending before the learned District Collector, East Godavari District. However, the charge sheet was filed in Cr.No.08 of 2025 of Gopalapuram Police Station for the alleged offences punishable under sections 318(4), 61(2) read with 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. And Section 7(1) of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955. ✓

Until the proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.500 of 2025 on the file of the learned II Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kovvur.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation, 2026, under the caption "Part-Heard'."
