The Court made the following ORDER:

Seeking an innocuous relief for a direction to the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Alur, to dispose of I.A.No.241/2025 in O.S.No.141/2025, the defendants filed the present Civil Revision Petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India.

2. Heard Sri Butta Vijaya Bhasker, learned counsel for the petitioners.

3. The respondents herein filed O.S.No.141/2025 for permanent injunction. Along with the suit they also filed I.A.No.241/2025 seeking ad-interim injunction. By order dt. 14.07.2025, the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Alur granted *ex-parte* interim injunction. Thereafter, the petitioners / defendants filed counter on 27.07.2025. From that date onwards I.A.No.241/2025 is being adjourned from time-to-time. The grievance of the petitioners is that the said I.A. was not disposed of from 27.07.2025 onwards. The petitioners' request is only to direct the trial Court to dispose of I.A.No.241/2025 as expeditiously as possible.

4. As no adverse orders are passed, there is no necessity to hear the respondents.

5. In view of the above facts and circumstances, the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Alur, Kurnool District, is directed to dispose of I.A.No.241/2025 in O.S.No.141/2025 as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after hearing both sides and after giving an opportunity to both sides.

With the above direction, this Civil Revision Petition is disposed of at the admission stage. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, interlocutory applications pending, if any, shall also stand closed.
