

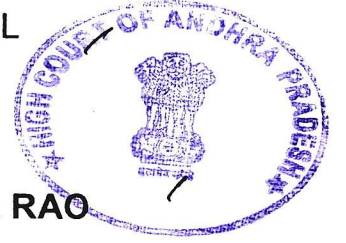

ORDER

“Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

A learned Single Judge of this court in CrI.P.No.4718 of 2022 on 13.07.2023 passed quashed proceedings in Cr.No.104 of 2022 of Obulavaripalli Police Station.

The Investigating officer has filed charge sheet in the above mentioned crime before the learned jurisdictional Magistrate for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 177 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, which was taken on file and assigned number as C.C.No.329 of 2023 pending on the file of Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Railway Koduru.

The Station House Officer Obulavaripalli Police Station shall appear before this Court on 28.04.2026.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.329 of 2023 on the file of Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Railway Koduru until the next date of hearing.
