Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings including the appearance of the petitioners/Accused Nos.2 & 3 in C.C. No. 51 of 2026 on the file of Learned Judicial First Class Magistrate, Kaikaluru, Pending disposal of CRLP No. 3248 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioners are the in-laws of the respondent No.2. They are aged about 62 years and 74 years respectively.

Considering the entire allegations leveled against the petitioner and the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms. Lakshmi Neelima, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 05.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation proceedings for amicable settlement of the dispute.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation 2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.51 of 2026 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kaikaluru.

The petitioners are at liberty to appear before the mediator either virtually or physically.
