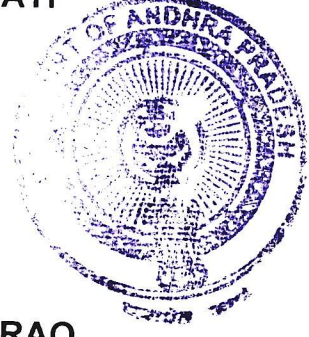

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the Orders in D.Dis.E3/626/2023, dated 01.04.2023 issued by the respondent No.2 ordering the respondent No.6 for cancellation of the Sale Deeds, dated 24.05.2022 and 05.12.2022 registered as document Nos.1738/2022 and 4621 of 2022 registered in my

favour for the land in an extent of 136.11 square yards in Sy.No.934 of Rajampeta Town and Mandal, Annamayya District and unilateral cancellation of the same, through the Cancellation Deed, dated 10.04.2023 registered as document No.1356 of 2023 executed by the respondent No.4, that too without putting the petitioner on notice as arbitrary, illegal and one without power or authority, contrary to the provisions of the Registration, Act, 1908 and the well established legal principles apart from being violative of the fundamental and Constitutional rights guaranteed to me under Articles 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently set aside the same.

IA NO: 1 OF 2023

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to dispossess the petitioner from the land in an extent of 136.11 square yards in Sy.No.934 of Rajampeta Village fields, Rajampeta, Annamayya District, pending disposal of WP 11062 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the cancellation deed, dated 10.04.2023 registered as Document No.1356 of 2023 executed by the respondent No.4, pending disposal of WP 11062 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.
