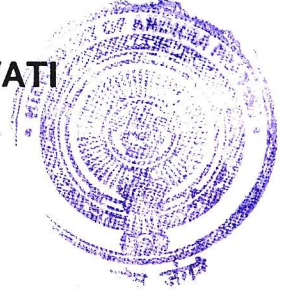

**IA NO: 2 OF 2026**

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings, including personal appearance of the Petitioner/Accused No.1 in C.C. No. 4570 of 2025 On the file of the II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada, NTR Krishna District, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3247 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

**The Court made the following: ORDER**

**Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.**

**Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.**

**The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.**

**The petitioner is aged about 54 years. The respondent No.2 is about 37 years. Their marriage was performed on 07.08.2016 nearly 10 years above. Subsequently, disputes arose between the Petitioner and Respondent No.2.**

**Considering the entire allegations leveled against the petitioner and the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.**

Mr.Mohan Rao Panchadi, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator for on 05.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with mediation proceedings for amicable settlement of the dispute.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.4570 of 2025 on the file of II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada, NTR Krishna District.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.
