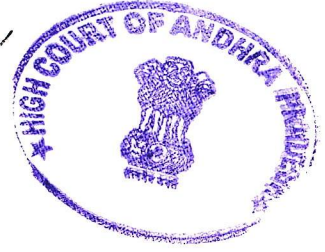

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court

may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one on the nature of a writ of mandamus declaring the action of the 4th respondent in not considering the case of petitioner for promotion to the post of Junior Assistant in the existing vacancies despite he acquired the qualification of Degree in the month of January, 2017 and issuing promotions to the post of Junior Assistants without following the roster points as per Rule 22 of A.P. State Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 is illegal, arbitrary, unjust and violative of Art. 14, 16 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for notional promotion in the cadre of Office Subordinate with effect from 31-12-2021 on par with others with all consequential benefits;

Petition under Section 151 CPC., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents 3 to 5 to consider and dispose of the representations dated 03-05-2025 and 04-02-2026 made by the petitioner forthwith, pending disposal of the above writ petition;

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 4th respondent to consider the case of petitioner for promotion to the post of Junior Assistant in the cadre of Office Subordinate as per his seniority and the qualification of Degree acquired in the Month of January, 2017 in the existing vacancies, pending disposal of the above writ petition;
