Petition under Section 438 (1) of BNSS/Under Section 397(1) of CrPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the operation of judgment dated 06-04-2026 passed in C.A. No.92 of 2024 on the

file of the V Additional District & Sessions Judge, Tirupati, in confirming the conviction and sentence imposed in C.C. No.143 of 2020 by the II Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tirupati, Pending disposal of CRLRC No. 434 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

ORDER:

"The instant petition has been filed by the Petitioner/Accused seeking to suspend the sentence imposed in C.C.No. 143 of 2020 by the learned II Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tirupati, which was confirmed in CrI.A.No.92 of 2024 on the file of the Court of V Additional District & Sessions Judge, Tirupati, dated 06.04.2026, pending disposal of the criminal revision.

Heard Sri O.Udaya Kumar, learned counsel for the Petitioner.

Learned counsel for the Petitioner /Accused would submit that, they have merits to succeed in the revision and it may take considerable time for disposal of the same. Hence, prayed to suspend the sentence of imprisonment imposed against the Petitioner pending disposal of the criminal revision case.

Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor is in attendance.

Considering the submissions made and in the facts and circumstances of the case, as the Petitioner preferred revision challenging the concurrent findings of the trial Court as well as the Appellate Court, and the hearing of the revision may take considerable time, this Court is suspending the sentence of imprisonment imposed against the Petitioner / Accused on the following terms.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the Petitioner / Accused shall be released on bail, on execution of a personal bond for Rs.20,000/-

(Rupees Twenty thousands only) with two sureties for the like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge.

The Petitioner shall deposit 50% of the cheque amount before the trial Court, within a period of two (02) weeks from the date of his release.

Petitioner shall appear before this Court as and when directed."
