Print the name of the Government Pleader for Home for the 5th respondent. This writ petition is filed questioning the action the 4th respondent in interfering with and attempting to dispossess the petitioner institution from the land admeasuring Ac.0.54 cents in R.S.No.50/4 of Janupalli Village, Amalapuram Mandal without following the due process of law and the inaction and collusive conduct of the 5th Respondent in not providing protection and aiding antisocial elements. On the other hand, the learned Assistant Government Pleader relying upon the written instructions of the 4th respondent dated 30.04.2026 submits that the 4th respondent has not made any attempt to dispossess the petitioner. No permission has been granted for any construction or development activity in the said land. The W.P.No.26738 of 2023 is already pending before this Hon'ble Court with respect to the same subject matter. In view of the above said facts and circumstances, list along with W.P.No.26738 of 2023 on 30.06.2026.	

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		In the meanwhile, there shall be an order of <i>status quo</i> as on today to be maintained with respect to the subject land in an extent of Ac.0.54 cents in R.S.No. 50/4 of Janupalli Village, Amalapuram Mandal till the next date of hearing.
