Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the action of the 3rd Respondent in interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the house site of the petitioner bearing Plot No. 24 situated in Sy No.581 of Machavaram Village, Kanigiri Mandal, Prakasam District due to political reasons at the behest of the ruling party as illegal, arbitrary and discriminative and violation of 14, 19 and 21 of Constitution of India, principles

of natural justice and politically motivated and without jurisdiction and consequently direct the Respondents not to dispossess the petitioner from the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the house site of the petitioner situated in Sy No.581 of Machavaram Village, Kanigiri Mandal, Prakasam District;
