WHEREAS the Petitioner/Accused above named through his Advocate SRI CHAVALI GANESH presented this Petition under Section Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for the records in Quash the Charge sheet (un-numbered) in Crime No. 208 of 2019 filed under section 306 IPC as altered from Section 174 Cr.PC on the file of Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Tiruvuru, Krishna District against the petitioner/accused is concerned and quash the same as abuse of process of law

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri CHAVALI GANESH Advocate for the Petitioner, ASSISTANT PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings Charge sheet (un-numbered) in Crime No. 208 of 2019 filed under section 306 IPC as altered from Section 174 Cr.PC on the file of Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Tiruvuru, Krishna District, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3261 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following order:

“Issue notice to Respondent No.2.

Learned Counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Because of the words uttered by the Petitioner the brother of Respondent No.2 committed suicide, those words alleged uttered by the

Petitioner ex-facie does not appear to be either abetment by instigation or abetment by intentional aid or abetment by conspiracy.

Therefore, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.208/2019 of Vissannapeta Police Station pending in PRC on the file of the learned Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Tiruvuru, until the next date of hearing.
