Petition under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure code/ Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings including arrest of the petitioner/Accused No. 4 in connection with Crime No. 49 of 2026 of Chirala I Town UPS, Bapatla District, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3257 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following order :

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioner/Accused No.4 is the married sister-in-law of respondent No.2 and is living separately with her husband.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Cr. No.49 of 2026 on the file of Chirala I Town Police Station, Bapatla District, until further orders.

The matter is referred to mediation.

Sri.P.V.Narasimha Rao, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 06.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report."
