Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the
circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be
pleased to issue Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the Nature of

Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in not releasing the retirement benefits to the petitioner, as highly illegal, improper, arbitrary, unjust and contrary to the A.P Co-Operative Central Bank Ltd., Staff Service Regulations and violative of Article 14, 16, and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to release the retirement benefits, which are due to the petitioner along with interest @ 14 % p.a from the date of retirement to till date.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to release the retirement benefits to the petitioner by considering the representations submitted by the petitioner dt.23.03.2022, dt.04.08.2023 and dt.04.09.2025 forthwith, Pending disposal of WP No.11538 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Gnaneswara Rao Mittireddi, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of GP for Services II for Respondent No.1, and of Sri N Siva Reddy, Advocate for the Respondent Nos. 2 to 5, the Court made the following.

ORDER

For filing counter, post the matter after summer vacation, 2026.

As the respondent authorities failed to release the retirement benefits payable to the petitioner, the petitioner submitted a representation dated 04.09.2025 requesting the authorities to consider and settle the same. However, despite submission of the said representation, the respondent authorities have not taken any action thereon till date.

Considering the aforesaid circumstances, there shall be an interim direction to the respondent authorities to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 04.09.2025 and take appropriate action in accordance with law and as per the available record, within a period of two (02) months from today.
