AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of MS KALLA TULASI DURGAMBA Advocate for the Petitioner, ASSISTANT PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure code/ Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to STAY all further proceedings including Arrest of the Petitioners 1 & 2 /Accused 2 & 3 in Crime No.101 of 2026 of East Police Station, Tirupati, registered for the offences under Sections 61(2), 305(a), 318(4), 351(2) read with 3(5)BNS pending disposal of CRLP No. 3267 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following order:

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. ✓

Issue notice to respondent No.2. ✓

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Since the alleged offences are punishable with imprisonment below seven years, the matter is referred to mediation.

Sri Tata Singaiah Goud, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 06.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, the Investigating Officer concerned is directed not to take any coercive steps against the petitioners/Accused Nos.2 and 3."
