Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or a direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of respondents in attempting to demolish the houses of petitioners at D.Nos.1-125 and 1-114 and dispossess them from the land admeasuring Ac. 0.03 cents each situated in Sy. No. 214 of

Vedanthapuram village, Tirupati Rural Mandal, Tirupati District as against law, highhanded, arbitrary and violative of Article 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India;

IA NO: 1 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be to direct the respondents not to dispossess the petitioners/ demolish their houses situated at D.Nos.1-125 and 1-114 in land admeasuring Ac. 0.03 cents Sy No. in 214 of Vedanthapuram village, Tirupati Rural Mandal, Tirupati District, pending disposal of WP.No.11638 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.
