ANJANA RAMA KAMESWARI, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS declaring the action of the Respondents in issuing the impugned Charge memo vide G.O. Rt. No. 583 Revenue (Vigilance-III) Department dated 16.06.2025 without verifying records and after an inordinate and unexplainable delay of 4 years from the date of the alleged incident as illegal,

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arbitrary, and violative of principles of natural justice and violative Articles 14,16 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently set-aside the impugned charge memo issued by Respondent No. 1;
