Petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed herein, the High Court may be pleased to allow the civil revision petition and setting aside the dismissal order in I.A.No.2045/2025 in O.S.No.1141/2019 on the file of the Rent Controller cum IV Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Division)-IV Addl. Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Vijayawada, dated 20.03.2026 and to order for, sending suit promissory note under Ex.A.1 to determine the age of the stamp i.e., when the stamp was printed at Government Security Press at Nasik, Maharashtra State and submit a detailed report

Vijayawada, dated 20.03.2026, till the disposal of civil revision petition and to pass, pending disposal of CIVIL REVISION PETITION 1237 of 2026, on the file of the High Court

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri KOGANTI NAGESWARA RAO Counsel for the Petitioner and the Court made the following.

ORDER:

The petitioner is the defendant in the suit filed by the respondent/plaintiff based on the promissory note for recovery of money. In the said suit, the defendant/petitioner filed I.A.No.2045 of 2025 to send the promissory note(Ex.A1) dated 20.03.2018 to the Work Manager, Revenue Stamp Examiner, Government Security Press, Nasik, Maharashtra, for examination and to find out when the stamp was printed at the Government Security Press at Nasik.

2. The said application has been dismissed by order dated 20.03.2026 and challenging the said order, the present Civil Revision Petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed.

3. On the first date i.e. on 01.05.2026, on the request of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the matter was adjourned.
