WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri HANUMANTHA RAO BACHINA presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds of criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for the records pertaining to FIR No.237/2025 dated 31.12.2025 on the file of Dargamitta Urban Police Station, Nellore and quash the same in the interests of justice further Direct the de-facto

complainants to participate in arbitration proceedings as provided under Clause 2 of the Franchisee Agreement dated 21.07.2025;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Hanumantha Rao Bachina, Advocate for the Petitioner and Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds of criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings including the arrest of the Petitioner in FIR No.237/2025 dated 31.12.2025 on the file of Dargamitta Urban Police Station, Nellore, pending disposal of CRLP No.3269 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Considering the nature of the transactions entered into between the petitioner/Accused No.1 and respondent No.2, the matter is referred to mediation.

Sri Tata Singaiah Goud, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 06.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, the Investigating Officer concerned is directed not to take any coercive steps against the petitioner/Accused No.1.
