Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS declaring the action of the Respondents in issuing the impugned Charge memo vide CCLA's Progs.No.REV02-28021/59/2020(e.1278986), dated 28.11.2024 (served on 26.11.2025) after an unexplained delay of 4 years after the date of the alleged incident as prejudicial, illegal, arbitrary, and violative of principles of natural justice and

violative Articles 14,16 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and contrary to the settled law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and consequently set-aside the impugned charge memo issued by the Respondent No. 2.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to SUSPEND the Impugned Charge Memo vide CCLA's Prcgs.No.REV02-28021/59/2020(e.1278986), dated 28.11.2024 (served on 26.11.2025), Pending disposal of WP No.10983 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to DIRECT the Respondents to consider the case of the Petitioner for promotion to the post of Tahsildar without reference to the impugned charge memo CCLA's Prcgs.No.REV02-28021/59/2020(e.1278986), dated 28.11.2024 (served on 26.11.2025) and pending disciplinary proceedings, Pending disposal of WP No.10983 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/s K Anjana Rama Kameswari, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of GP for Revenue for the Respondent Nos. 1 & 2, the Court made the following.
