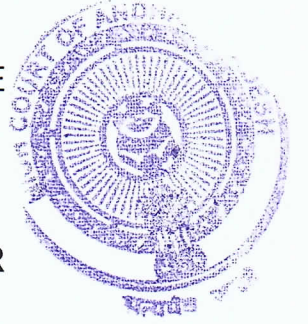

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the notice of the 3rd respondent in Ref.B2/2835/2024, dated 21.04.2025 thereby directing the petitioner to attend for enquiry on 24.04.2025 in the office of the 3rd respondent with proper documents pertaining to my Fair Price Shop No-1117023, K.Timmapuram Village &Muddanur Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, as illegal, irregular, arbitrary and in gross violation of principal of natural justice and without jurisdiction and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of constitution of India and consequently grant stay of operation of notice of the 3rd respondent in Ref.B2/2835/2024, dated 21.04.2025.
