No. 112 of 2025 on the file of VI ADDITIONAL JUNIOR CIVIL JUDGE, RAJAMAHENDRAVARAM;

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioners are the in-laws of respondent No.2. Respondent No.2 has also instituted a case in Cr.No.122 of 2025 against the petitioners and her husband for the alleged offence punishable under Section 498-A of 'the IPC'.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms.Anumula Sudha Varshini, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 06.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator. The learned trained mediator is also directed to conduct mediation in Cr.No.122 of 2025.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in D.V.C.No.112 of 2025 on the file of the learned VI Additional Junior Civil Judge, Rajamahendravaram.
