ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned Government Pleader for respondents.

2. The Writ Petition is filed declaring the action of the 2nd respondent in not adjudicating the interim prayer in appeal filed by the petitioner against the proceedings of the respondent No.3 dated 11.01.2026.

3. The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondents without appreciating the facts, have issued orders for compulsory retirement *vide* order dated 11.01.2026 as against the petitioner without considering the appeal filed before the 2nd respondent on 11.02.2026, along with the appeal the petitioner has also filed stay application to interim stay the order dated 11.01.2026. Despite his efforts, the 2nd respondent has not considered and passed any orders on the suspension application filed. Hence the Writ Petition.

4. Considering the submissions made and without going into the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of this Writ Petition.

5. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing the 2nd respondent to consider the appeal filed by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders. If the appeal could not be disposed of, the respondents may consider the suspension/stay application filed along with the appeal. The said exercise shall be completed within a period of (15) days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
