Heard Sri O. Manohar Reddy, learned Senior Counsel appearing Sri P. Sravan Kumar Reddy, learned Counsel for the Petitioners.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned Counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to the Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The Petitioners/Accused Nos.2 to 4 are the in-laws of Respondent No.2. The marriage between Accused No.1 and Respondent No.2 was performed on 04.08.2017, and they lived together for about three months. Thereafter, they have been residing separately from the in-laws.

Respondent No.3 was residing in the United States of America from 2016 to 2022. After returning to India, he has been living separately with his wife.

Respondent No.2 submitted a complaint to Respondent No.1, which is a typed report running into four pages.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in Crime No.27 of 2026 on the file of the Mahila Urban Police Station, Anantapuramu until further orders.

Smt. Kesavi Kumari Nemala, learned Counsel is appointed as trained Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 06.05.2026 or any other convenient date for both the parties and the mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.
