Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the high handed and illegal action on the part of the respondents no. 3 to 5 in attempting to dispossess the petitioner from her possession and enjoyment of their house plot no. 6 situated to an extent of Ac. 0.02 Cents in Survey No. 1747 of Bukkapatnam Village and Mandal, Sri Satya Sai District, without issuing any notice, without conducting any enquiry and without passing any order the respondents nos. 3 to 5 trying to dispossess us from our peaceful possession as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, malafide and against the principles of Natural Justice besides violation of Article 14, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and to consequently direct the respondents nos 3 to 5 not to interfere with the possession and enjoyment of the petitioners in any manner including the dispossession from the subject land in the interest of justice

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents no. 3 to 5 in attempting to dispossess the petitioner from her possession and enjoyment of their house plot no. 6 situated to an extent of Ac. 0.02 Cents in Survey No. 1747 of Bukkapatnam Village and Mandal, Sri Satya Sai District, in any manner including their dispossession, during the pendency of the writ petition, in the interest of justice pending disposal of the above writ petition

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri S LAKSHMI PRAMEELA Advocate for the Petitioner(s), GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondent Nos. 1 to 4, GP for Home for respondent No.5, and the Court made the following.

ORDER

The possession certificate issued by the 4th respondent-Tahsildar constitutes prima facie evidence of the possession.

Hence, there shall be an interim direction to the respondents not to take any coercive steps against the subject property i.e., plot No.6 admeasuring Ac.0.02 cents in Survey No.1747 of Bukkapatnam Village and Mandal, Sri Satya Sai District, for a period of ten (10) weeks. Particularly, the 5th respondent is directed not to call the petitioner to the police station.
