WHEREAS the Petitioner/Accused above named through their Advocate Sri PENUMAKA VENKATA RAO presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings in C.C. No. 584 of 2025 On the file of the Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate at Jaggaiahpetta, NTR District against the Petitioners/Accused Nos.1 & 2;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri PENUMAKA VENKATA RAO Advocate for the Petitioner, Public Prosecutor

for R1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted on or before 15.06.2026 for which date the case stands posted for hearing.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings, including personal appearance of the Petitioners/Accused Nos.1 & 2 in C.C. No. 584 of 2025 On the file of the Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate at Jaggaiahpetta, NTR District, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3318 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The original cause of action arose on 13.03.2025. Subsequently, another cause of action arose on 22.04.2025. However, Respondent No.2 lodged the complaint on 28.04.2025. Thus, there is a delay of nearly four days from the subsequent cause of action. Moreover, there is a delay of more than forty days from the earlier cause of action.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mrs.A.Sukha Veni, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 07.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.584 of 2025 on the file of the learned Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Jaggaiahpetta, NTR District.
