No.212 of 2024 under Section 13(1)(ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act seeking dissolution of marriage on the ground of cruelty. The said petition was allowed, granting an ex-parte divorce. Respondent No.2 has also filed a case in Cr.No.169 of 2024 on the file of Ramachandrapuram Police Station on 27.07.2024 for the alleged offences punishable under Section 85 of 'the BNSS' and Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961. 		Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation. Mr.D.Kishore Kumar, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case. The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard. The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time. The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 06.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator. The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement. Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report. Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.169 of 2024 on the file Ramachandrapuram Police Station. _____ Dr.YLR,J RSI
