WHEREAS the Petitioner/Accused above named through his Advocate Sri Sudharsana Reddy J presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to exercise its inherent powers under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and be pleased to quash the proceedings in Crime No. 27 of 2026 dated 04.03.2026 on the file of Ramapuram Police Station, Annamayya District, registered for the alleged offences under Sections 132, 351(2) read with 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, in so far as the petitioner/Accused No.4 namely Sai @ Sai Nisanth is concerned;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Sudharsana Reddy J Advocate for the Petitioner, Public Prosecutor for R1

directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted on or before summer vacation, 2026.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay all further proceedings, including investigation, arrest, coercive steps or any other action pursuant to Crime No. 27 of 2026 dated 04.03.2026 on the file of Ramapuram Police Station, Annamayya District, in so far as the petitioner/Accused No.4 is concerned, pending disposal of the petitioner/Accused No.4 is concerned, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3290 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The alleged offences levelled against the Petitioner/Accused No.4 are punishable with imprisonment for less than seven (07) years.

In the meanwhile, the Investigating Officer is directed to comply with the guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court in *Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar*¹, and also with the provisions of Section 35(3) of the *Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023* (for brevity, 'the BNSS').

However, the petitioner is directed to cooperate with the Investigating Officer, and the Investigating Officer may proceed with the further investigation. In the course of investigation, if it is noticed that the petitioner has committed any offence punishable with imprisonment beyond seven years, the Investigating Officer is at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.
