01.	23.04.2026	<u>VGKR,J</u> <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> Heard learned counsel for the petitioner. The averments in the affidavit filed by the petitioner <i>prima facie</i> shows that the petitioner is none other than the wife of the respondent/husband, due to the matrimonial disputes between both the parties, the petitioner/wife is residing separately at Vijayawada in her parents' house. The averments in the affidavit filed by the petitioner <i>prima facie</i> further show that the petitioner lodged a complaint <i>vide</i> F.I.R.No.454 of 2025 before the A.S. Nagar police station and she filed a maintenance case <i>vide</i> F.C.O.P.No.22 of 2026 on the file of the Principal Family Court-cum-IV Additional District Judge at Vijayawada and the same is pending adjudication. Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that the respondent/husband filed F.C.O.P.No.360 of 2025, on the file of the learned Judge, Family Court, Rajamahendravaram, seeking dissolution of marriage under Section 13 (1) (ia) (ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, and the same is pending adjudication. Learned counsel for the petitioner would further contend that the petitioner/wife has been residing separately at Vijayawada in her parents' house depending upon the mercy of	

her parents and the distance between the Vijayawada and Rajamahendravaram is more than 100 kms and it is very difficult for the petitioner/wife to attend the case proceedings in F.C.O.P.No.360 of 2025, on the file of the learned Judge, Family Court, Rajamahendravaram, on each and every adjournment without any male assistance and that she is constrained to file the present transfer petition.

Perused the record.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and for the reasons mentioned in the accompanying affidavit, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings including the appearance of the petitioner, i.e., the respondent in F.C.O.P.No.360 of 2025, on the file of the learned Judge, Family Court, Rajamahendravaram, till 15.06.2026.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to takeout personal notice to the respondent through Registered Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service before the Registry.

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ADMIT.

Issue notice to the respondent.

List the matter on 15.06.2026.
