Petition Under Section 528 of B.N.S.S/Old Under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including the appearance of the petitioners/accused No. 2 to 4 including their appearance in C.C. No. 1870 of 2025 on the file of Addl. Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kadiri which arose out of Cr. No. 407/2025 of Kadiri Town Police Station, Sri Satya Sai District and pending disposal of CRLP No. 3295 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.1.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.1 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioners/Accused Nos.2 to 4 are the in laws of respondent No.1.

Considering the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioners, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. D.V.Vara Prasad, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.1 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 06.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.1870 of 2025 on the file of the learned Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kadiri.
