

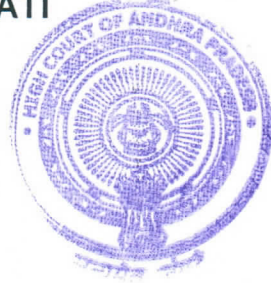

WHEREAS the Petitioner/Accused above named through their Advocate Sri. O UDAYA KUMAR presented this Petition under Section 482 of CRPC & 528 of BNSS, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for the records in C.C.No. 783 of 2025 on the file of I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Adoni, Kurnool District and quash the same against the petitioners/Accused No. 1 to 5

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit/memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri O UDAYA KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent NO.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRLP should not be admitted on or before Summer Vacation, 2026 for which date the case stands posted for hearing;

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS/ U/s 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the Petitioners/Accused No.1 to 5 in C.C.No. 783 of 2025 on the file of I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Adoni, Kurnool District, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3304 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

There exists a land dispute between the Petitioners and Respondent No.2. Respondent No.2 has suffered simple injuries. The alleged offences are compoundable in nature. One of the Petitioners has also lodged a case against Respondent No.2, which was registered as Crime No.46 of 2025.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, gravity and nature of the allegations leveled against the Petitioners by the Respondent No.2, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms.Rayudu Sudha, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 07.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.783 of 2025 on the file of the learned I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Adoni.
