**The Court made the following: ORDER**

**Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.**

**Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.**

**The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.**

**The son of the Respondent No.2 and the Petitioner are friends. They had allegedly engaged in certain business dealings in which the Petitioner owes Rs. 90,00,000/- to the son of Respondent No.2. The root cause of the action appears to be civil in nature.**

**Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.**

**Mr.Venkata Narasayya Pattisapu, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.**

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioner and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 07.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.1007 of 2025 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Nandyal.
