No. 03/2025 on the file

of Court of Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Atmakur registered against the petitioners herein and to quash the same.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of M/s Ayesha Azma S, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the petitioners herein in connection with the proceedings vide D.V.C. No. 03/2025 on the file of Court of Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Atmakur registered against the petitioners herein, Pending disposal of CRLP No.3305 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners submits that Respondent No.2 has also lodged a complaint against some of the Petitioners for the alleged offences punishable under Section 498-A of 'the I.P.C.,' and Sections 3 and 4 of 'the D.P Act'.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms.Umadevi Manchala, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

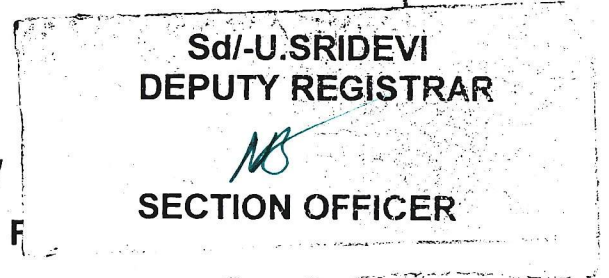
The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 07.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in D.V.C.No.03 of 2025 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Atmakur.
