IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition Under Section 528 of B.N.S.S/Old Under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in STC. No. 610 of 2022 on the file of II Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tirupati, Chittoor District, including appearance of the petitioner/accused, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3311 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

“Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The reason for dishonor of the cheque is not ‘FUNDS INSUFFICIENT’. The reason was ‘WRONGLY DELIVERED /NOT DRAWN ONUS’.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr.Viswanadha S.S.Pavaki, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioner and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 07.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation–2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a limited stay of all further proceedings in S.T.C.No.610 of 2022 on the file of the learned II Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tirupati."
