The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. Respondent No.2 has lodged a complaint against the petitioners for the alleged offence punishable under Section 498-A of 'the IPC' and Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961. The petitioners are the aged in-laws of respondent No.2. Respondent No.2 has also filed D.V.C.No.01 of 2026 against the petitioners. Considering the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioners, the matter is referred to mediation. Ms.Gatala Raja Sree, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case. The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard. The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later	Contd...

point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 06.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

List this Criminal Petition along with CrI.P.No.3307 of 2026.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.158 of 2025 on the file of the learned Junior Civil Judge-Cum-Judicial First Class Magistrate, Lakkireddypalli, YSR Kadapa District.
