State of (NCT) of Delhi³, Prithivirajan v. State⁴, Pramod Suryabhan Pawar v. State of Maharashtra⁵, Maheshwar Tigga v. State of Jharkhand⁶. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation. Sri Renu Chakravarthy Kanadam, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.
